Course of instruction is **designed for persons who have been assigned to oversee range operations and safety**. Course includes: Ensuring the range is safe to use, conducting range safety briefings for shooters, handling ammunition and firearm malfunctions safely, supervising safety aspects of shooting activities and handling emergency procedures as established by the range management.

Many shooting organizations, clubs, and ranges have determined that their facilities need to be managed and operated by qualified people due to the lack of training specifically for range safety personnel.

In response, the National Rifle Association developed the Basic Range Safety Officer Course to satisfy the need to have trained persons oversee and conduct safe range operations.

More trained members within your club or facility can help lower insurance rates, provide greater safety, and improve community relations.

It is **not** necessary to be an NRA Certified Instructor or Coach to take this course.

This is an advanced TWO FULL day course and will include Chief RSO Certification to active NRA Instructors meeting specific qualifications
