

**PRELIMINARY ANNOUNCEMENTS REGARDING THE 2008 WISCONSIN
STATE OUTDOOR BULLSEYE PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP, 3-29-08**

Due to plans for range renovation at the Beloit Rifle Club, the 2008 WISCONSIN STATE OUTDOOR BULLSEYE PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP will be held at the MENOMONEE FALLS ROD & GUN CLUB in Sussex, Wisconsin. The event will be held on the Weekend of AUGUST 23/24.

It will be an 1800 event with the format of “60, 60, 60” meaning 60 rounds .22; 60 rounds CF; and 60 rounds .45. (2 slow fire, 2 timed fire, and 2 rapid fire targets of each category.) Individual relays will start at 9 AM on SATURDAY, AUGUST 23 RD, 9 AM SUNDAY AUGUST 24 TH, and 1:30 PM SUNDAY, AUGUST 24TH. The EIC and DISTINGUISHED REVOLVER MATCHES will be held on SATURDAY, AUGUST 23RD **ONLY**, with two relays scheduled for each of these special events. These relays will start with the EIC event at 2 PM and the DISTINGUISHED REVOLVER match as soon as practical after the 2nd EIC relay (1st “distinguished revolver” relay should start at approximately 3:30 PM.) Cost will be \$40 for the 1800 Championship with nominal (“tbd”) fees for the EIC and DR matches.

I am pleased to host this event and hope that I can have a “full house.” A word of explanation about the limitations (Why an 1800?, etc.): The facility is limited to 19 firing points (1 or 2 additional points MAY be added; however, the limit is 19 as of this writing.) The club also has a rule that prohibits shooting prior to 9 AM. The 1800 format is the only practical way to get a reasonable number of competitors the opportunity to compete, AND offer the EIC and Distinguished Revolver events. The limiting of the EIC and DR events to “one day” complies with CMP rules (for EIC event), and evens the field to have all special events shooting on one day. It also keeps the events from running into early evening hours!

Because of the limited number of firing points, the squading of non-Wisconsin residents will be restricted until August 1. Any non-resident can be placed on a “waiting list” prior to August 1st, and will be assigned and accepted (in the order of requests received) to any available spots AFTER August 1st. Please understand that I appreciate the past support of “out of state” competitors at our states’ previous matches, both “Championship” and otherwise. It is my hope, that I can accommodate all who apply; however, I also want to give State of Wisconsin shooters a 1st choice to fill the limited number of spaces. The Beloit Rifle Club plans to resume hosting of this event in 2009 and beyond. I thank you in advance for your understanding and support. The official bulletin is awaiting formal NRA approval and will be available as soon as possible.
