**Entry fees:** One Event = \$18.00  
Both Events = \$28.00  
Team = \$10.00 per event

**Eligibility:** This competition is open to all U.S. citizens born in 1989 or later. All competitors must be individual members of USA shooting. Membership forms will be available at the match, cost \$20.00.

**Residence:** Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Non-residents may compete for automatic and at-large invitations to the Nationals Championship and are encourage doing so.

**STATE RESIDENT  
QUALIFIERS:**

USA Shooting will issue official invitations to the National Junior Olympic Shooting Championships (NJOSC) for the high scoring male and high scoring female residence from each state JOSOC, provided they fire a minimum qualifying score. Resident collegiate and/or military competitors are eligible for the state resident champion awards and are also eligible for resident state qualifier invitations.

**ENTRY:** **Resident Qualifier-** Competitors shooting in their declared state of permanent residency. Competitors in this category are eligible to be the state resident qualifier to the National JOSOC.

**Automatic/At Large-** Competitors shooting in other than their declared state of residency are eligible for at-large/automatic invitations to the National JOSOC.

**TEAMS:** All teams entered in the team competition must represent USAS affiliated clubs. Teams will consist of three firing members.

**CATEGORIES:** The following categories will be used for individual and team competition:

**Junior (J1);** age 18-20; competitors born from 1989-1991

**Intermediate Junior (J2);** age 15-17; competitors born from 1992-1994

**Sub-Junior (J3);** age 14 & under; competitors born in 1995 or later

**RULES:** Current USA Shooting Rules will govern.

**COURSE OF FIRE:**

Men's 60 shot Air Rifle: Three 20-shot stages of 35 min.

Women's 40-shot Air Rifle: Two 20-shot stages of 37.5 min.

Men's and Women's 3x20Smallbore: 40 min. prone

60 min. Standing

50 min. Kneeling

**FIREARM INFO:** Smallbore-.22 cal. Air Rifle-.177 cal.

**SIGHTS INFO:** Only metallic sights in accordance with Rule 7.4.2.3 permitted.

**DISTANCE:** Smallbore-50 ft. Air Rifle-10 m.

**TARGETS:** Smallbore- Official USA Shooting 50 ft. target Air Rifle –AR-5

**COACHING:** Coaching will not be permitted.

**SCORING**

**PROTESTS:** No fee will be charged for scoring protests.

**TIES:** All ties will be broken in accordance with USA Shooting Rules.

**SCORE SHEETS:** **Special score sheets must be used.** They are to be filled in completely and signed by the competitor to be considered for invitation to the National JOSCS. **LEGIBLE** handwriting is required. If we cannot read your handwriting you may not get your invitation.

**AWARDS:** USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top resident individual, silver medallion for the 2<sup>nd</sup> place resident individual and a bronze medallion for the 3<sup>rd</sup> place resident individual.

Class awards will be provided based on the following schedule:

3-6	1 <sup>st</sup> in class
7-11	1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> in class
12 or more	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , and 3 <sup>rd</sup> in class

Teams awards will be provided based on the following schedule:

Match Champion  
1<sup>st</sup> in class (if two or more in class)
