

ANNOUNCING: THE 5th ANNUAL DARLINGTON RIFLE CLUB 80 SHOT SPORTING .22 RIFLE OPEN

Saturday and Sunday, March 7-8 2009

Bring your favorite hunting .22 and test your marksmanship at our indoor range. Match is open to all competitors with a standard .22 rifle.

Course of fire:

Contestants will fire 80 shots in total at 4 different positions – shot at 50 feet.

20 shots rested	20 shots prone
20 shots kneeling	20 shots standing

The shooter with the highest total out of 800 points will be the winner. Cash awards will be given for the top two or three shooters in each class. Cash awards may also be given for position winners. Door prizes will be given out for each relay.

Regulations on equipment:

- Rifles should be of common hunting variety, weighing no more than 8 lbs.
- Triggers must have at least a 2 lb. Pull
- Scopes may not be set higher than 9X
- No special supportive clothing or supportive attachments may be worn or used.
- Any standard .22 ammunition is allowed.

Time and place:

We will shoot in shifts starting at 9:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., and 3:00 p.m. each day. A shift may be canceled if there is low interest in that time. To reserve a spot in your preferred time slot please call ahead. Contact Pete Wiegel (776-4786) or Tom Steger (822-4142) to sign up, or mail in the attached entry form. Additional time slots may be available for those who show up at the range on a first come – first served basis.

Our rifle building is located at the top of Spring Street in Darlington

Entry fee:

\$10.00 American - Pay at the range.

Directions to the range

From the North (Hwy 23) Stay on 23 to the bottom of Main Street and cross the bridge at the bottom. Immediately take the first left after crossing the bridge. At the stop sign, turn right (Spring Street), and go up the hill. The range is on the right hand side surrounded by pine trees.

From the East (Hwy 81) Stay on 81 to Main Street. Turn left down Main Street and cross the bridge. Turn right at the stop sign (Spring Street) and go up the hill. The range is on the right hand side surrounded by pine trees.

From the South (Hwy 81 or 23). Stay on 81/23 until right before the bridge at the bottom of main street. Turn right immediately before the bridge to the stop sign. Turn right (Spring Street), and go up the hill. The range is on the right hand side surrounded by pine trees.
