THE COURSE:

- This is a basic pistol course for individuals who want to learn more in depth and gain more hands-on experience with the pistol..
- NRA Basic Pistol Course teaches the basic knowledge, skills and attitude needed for the owning and use of a firearm safely. Students will learn about the firearms parts and operation, ammunition, gun safety and handling, and selection a firearm and much more.

 - Firearm parts and operation
 - Ammunition and its function
 - Shooting fundamentals and development
 - How to select, clean and store a firearm
 - Review of activities available to develop and improve shooting skills
