

# Competition Rifle Shooting Classes

The Border States Rifle Club will be hosting a day of instructional classes in order to introduced potential competitors to the sport of position rifle shooting.

This will give first time shooters a chance to be trained by expert marksman/women prior to competing in their first NRA Approved match. (*BSRC first match of 2009 will be Sunday June, 7*)

This course is open to all Juniors (ages 12 thru 20) and Adults who are interested in learning about shooting the Service Rifle or Match Rifle. *Service Rifles* are classed as the US Models .30M1 Garand ,M1A Springfield, or the AR15 variants. *Match rifles* are any center fire rifle capable of holding a minimum of 5 rounds with detachable magazines. Individuals who have their own rifles are encouraged to use them.

## **Saturday June 6 ,2009**

**Equipment:** There will be rifles and ammunition available. You must let us know in advance if you will need a rifle and/or ammunition.

**Fees:** \$10.00 registration (Junior shooters ½ price)

Ammunition cost (if needed) will be about \$18

### **Class Schedule:**

8:00	Range safety and familiarization of rifles
8:30	Match procedures and scoring
9:30	Individual instruction and shooting (each participant will be coached one on one with an experienced competitive shooter) Approximately 60 shots will be fired, all from the 200 yard line.

### **Location:**

From Gwinn- 557 south to Arnold, then take 426 east to Watson. Follow signs(7 miles) to the Superior Game Ranch Shooting Range.

From Escanaba- Take 426 north to Cornell. Then take 523 north(9 miles) to the range.

From Felch- Take 581 north to Ralph. Then take 426 east to Watson. Follow signs (7mile) to the Superior Game Ranch shooting range.
