**DATES: April 9<sup>th</sup>, 10th and 11th, 2010**

**LOCATION:** North of Beloit on Philhower Road between Prairie and old US 51

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Shooters. To be the Wisconsin State Champion, or recipient of any State Champion class award, you must be a Wisconsin Resident and a member of WI-FORCE

**FEES:** .22 only -- \$30.00 Across the board ---\$40.00

**ENTRY:** Limited to 50 shooters. Three days, 1 relay Fri(10), 2 relays Sat(20)/Sun(20).

**FACILITIES:** 10 point 50 foot range with turning target paddles.

- NOTES:**
1. This will be an NRA registered tournament, all NRA rules apply.
  2. Challenge fee --- \$1.00(returned if sustained)
  3. Competitors will be classified according to the most current NRA classification system. Classification card, or temporary score book, MUST be shown during check in.
  4. Competitors will score and change targets. Overlays may be used - plugs will be handled by range people only.
  5. Entries in aggregate matches will close when the first match in that aggregate is fired.
  6. Confirmation will be assumed for those shooters who send fees with registration. If you must cancel, please call. No Call = No Refund. There will be a \$5.00 charge deducted from refund if cancellation is three (3) days, or less, prior to the match.

Number of competitors required for the class awards: 5 for 1st place, 10 for 2nd place, 15 for 3rd place and 20 for 4th place. Any class with less than 5 competitors will be grouped in the next higher class. If the High Master class has fewer than 5 shooters, they will be eligible for Match Winner only.
