**SMALL ARMS FIRING SCHOOL & CAMP PERRY FUND MATCH
May 15-16, 2010**

SPONSORED BY: Wisconsin Firearm Owners, Ranges, Clubs and Educators, Inc. (WI-FORCE)
Winnequah Gun Club , Inc.

LOCATION: The Winnequah Gun Club range, approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). *New Entrance: Continue on J and V approximately one mile. Continue on Cty Hwy V approximately 1/4 mile to the new Indoor Range building on the left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the new road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. Signs will be posted.* Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles.

Funds that came from DCM/CMP are no longer available. We must do our own fund raising. One of the reasons for this school and match is to raise funds for the Teams going to Camp Perry, Ohio. Think of your entry fees as a donation for the support of our WI-FORCE Teams to represent the State of Wisconsin. No awards will be given.

This course is designed to introduce Juniors and Unclassified individuals with the Service Rifle or Match Rifle in High Power Rifle competition. This will give first time High Power Rifle shooters a chance to be trained by expert marksmen/women prior to competing in their first NRA Approved or Registered Match.

This course is open to all Juniors age 12 thru 20 who are interested in learning about shooting the Service Rifle or Match Rifle. This course is also open to Unclassified adults who are unfamiliar with High Power Rifle competition and shooting. Unclassified competitive shooters from another shooting discipline, or Classified High Power Rifle competitors. There will be an experienced adult at each firing point to enforce range and safety rules and act as Coach.

All Juniors and other participants in the school can use the Service Rifle or Match Rifle. Participants who are trying out for the WI-FORCE Junior or Adult Teams are required to attend the school and the Camp Perry Fund Match. Service Rifles must be used to qualify for both Teams.

Service Rifles are classed as the U.S. Models .30 M1 or caliber 7.62mm M1; M14; 5.56mm M16 or commercial equivalent such as Springfield Armory M1A, or Colt AR15. Individuals who have their own rifles are encouraged to use them.

EQUIPMENT: There may be shooting coats, mats, gloves and spotting scopes available for people to use.

FEES: Saturday or Sunday: \$20.00

CAMP PERRY FUND MATCH

May 16, 2010

LOCATION: The Winnequah Gun Club range, approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). *New Entrance: Continue on J and V approximately one mile. Continue on Cty Hwy V approximately ¼ mile to the new Indoor Range building on the left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the new road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. Signs will be posted.* Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles.

This match is open to all interested individuals ages 12 and up. The purpose of this match is to raise funds to send Teams from the State of Wisconsin to the National Matches at Camp Perry, Ohio. NRA and WI-FORCE membership is not required to fire in this match, however, membership applications will be available and accepted at the Stat Office.

All Adults and Juniors who will be trying out for the WI-FORCE Teams **MUST** indicate so on the entry form before shooting the Camp Perry Fund Match.

Individual WI-FORCE resident members wanting to try out for the 2010 WI-FORCE High Power Rifle Teams will be required to fire this match using the Service Rifle. **The Team Captain and Team Members will be selected from scores fired in this match. It is mandatory all Team Members attend one of the NMC State Championship matches.** All other individuals may use the NRA Match Rifle equipped with metallic sights as described in NRA Rule(s) 3.3 and 3.7. There will be separate classes for the Service Rifle and NRA Match Rifle.

COURSE OF FIRE: 80 shot Regional Match Course – 2 sighting shots will be taken at each stage
20 shots Standing at 200 yards – 20 minutes
20 shots Sitting from standing at 200 yards, fired in two (2) ten (10) shot strings – 60 seconds each
20 shots Prone from standing at 300 yards, fired in two (2) ten (10) shot strings – 70 seconds each
20 shots Prone at 600 yards – 20 minutes

FIRING TIME: Firing will begin promptly at 8:00 am. Individuals should be on the firing line no later than 7:45.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle rules will apply.

EQUIPMENT – RIFLES: Service Rifles must conform to NRA 3.1, 3.1.1, or 3.1.2. NRA Match Rifles must conform to NRA 3.3 equipped with metallic sights per NRA 3.7(a). Ammunition conforming to NRA 3.17 will be used.

Use of shooting coats, pants, ground cloth or pads, gloves, slings, spotting scopes and padding conforming to current NRA rules will be allowed.

PROHIBITED: Use of Palm Rests, Schuetzen type butt plates, release triggers and any form of compensator or muzzle brake is specifically prohibited.

REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES: Advance Registration recommended. Use attached entry form. Post entries will be accepted to the capacity of the range (112). Entries close at 7:30 am on Sunday, May 16, 2010.
