

Racine County Line Rifle Club
Art Schrader Memorial Invitational Rifle Match
“across the course 80”

Date: June 20th, 2010

Fee: \$20 seniors \$15 juniors \$10

Entry: register at the club house between 7:30 and 8:30 am. No advanced entry required.

Firing will commence at ~ 9 am, at the 200 yd. line.

Rules: NRA rules will apply.

Equipment: NRA rifles and Service Rifles, spotting scopes, ground mats, etc.

Course of fire: (80 rounds for record, 800 points aggregate) Each stage of fire will include 2 sighting shots and 20 rounds for record.

Stage 1: 200 yards offhand slow fire, firing at the SR target. Time limit 22 minutes

Stage 2: 200 yards sitting or kneeling rapid fire. Two minute sighting period followed by two strings of 10 shots with mandatory reload (5 and 5 or 2 and 8 for service rifles). Time limit of 60 seconds per string. Firing on the SR target.

Stage 3: 300 yards prone rapid fire. Two minute sighting period followed by two strings of 10 shots with mandatory reload (5 and 5 or 2 and 8 for service rifles). Time limit of 70 seconds per string. Firing on the SR-3 target.

Stage 4: 600 yards prone slow fire, firing on the MR-1 target. Time limit of 22 minutes.

Stages 1 and 2 will be run consecutively for efficiency of the match.

Competitors will shoot, score and perform pit and other duties as assigned.

A fee of \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge.

Eye and hearing protection is mandatory for all competitors while firing is ongoing.

Use of empty chamber indicator is required.

Awards: cash award or engraved plaque for each high score in class and category and to match winner. Awards for category (senior, junior, woman, military, police and service rifle) and class limited to those classes and categories where at least 5 entries are made.

Classifications will be combined where less than 5 entries are made. High Master classification will not be combined with any other classification and will be eligible for match winner only, if less than 5 are entries are made. Where more than 10 (and 15) entries are made in a class or category, a second (and third) place award will be made.

All *net* proceeds to M-1 for Vets program.
