Wisconsin Service Rifle State Championship Matches

Saturday, July 17th: Individual Service Rifle Championship (and 600 yard stage of team match).

Sunday, July 18th: Service Rifle Team Match (200 and 300 yard stages).

Sunday, July 18th: CMP Excellence in Competition Match (“leg” match).

Check-in at RCLRC clubhouse from 6:30-7:30 each day.

Individual Service Rifle Championship Match 7-17-10

80 rounds for record, with 2 sighting shots at each stage

Fee: adult \$25 Senior: \$20 Junior: \$15

Entries: advanced entry accepted and encouraged, but not required. You must be eligible to possess firearms in the State of Wisconsin to participate. Advanced entry preference given to WI residents until 7-12-10, followed by open entry. **Entry can be made up to 7:30 am on 7-17-10 or until entry limit of 64 competitors is reached.**

Rules: Current NRA rules will apply.

Equipment: U.S. Service Rifles, as defined by NRA rules, must be used in these matches. Spotting scopes, ground mats, slings, etc. allowed.

Targets: Decimal SR, SR3 and MR

Course of fire: (competitors will shoot, score and perform pit and other duties as assigned)

Stage 1: 200 yards offhand slow fire with 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record in time of 22 minutes.

Stage 2: 200 yards rapid fire sitting or kneeling with 2 sighting shots and 2 strings of 10 shots, with reload, in 60 seconds.

Stage 3: 300 yards rapid fire prone with 2 sighting shots and 2 strings of 10 shots , with reload, in 70 seconds.

Stage 4: 600 yards slow fire prone with 2 sighting shots and 20 record shots in 22 minutes.

Stages 1 and 2 will be run consecutively for efficiency of the match.

Awards: cash awards to match (aggregate) winner, winners in class and category (woman, junior, senior, military, and police). Award for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place only if there are 5, 10 and 15 etc. competitors in class and category. If there are fewer than 5 NRA classified High Masters they will compete for match winner only. If there are fewer than 5 competitors in any class they will be combined with the next higher class. High Master class will not be combined with any other class. Unclassified competitors will be combined with the Master class. Awards for high aggregate slow fire and high aggregate rapid fire scores.

WI FORCE travelling trophies, as available, will be awarded to Wisconsin resident WI FORCE members only. Only Wisconsin resident WI FORCE members will earn WI FORCE State Champion titles and receive travelling trophies. (A separate cash award will be given to the high scoring person shooting a match rifle, provided there are at least 5 competitors in that category. Match rifle competitors are eligible for this award only.)

In addition to the cash and trophy awards there will be **several door prizes of substantial value**. All competitors will be eligible for the door prizes. **Must be present to win**. Drawing is to follow the completion of the match. Not a raffle.

Door prizes donated for this event include:

Northern Competition AR-15 “Upper”. (1/4’x1/4’ pinned, rear match sight. Floated, match grade, 1 in 8 twist, broach-cut barrel. Ready for you to put onto your AR lower).

Creedmore Sports shooting stool.

Creedmore Sports roll-up shooting mat/ ground cloth.

More prizes are being sought.

Eye and hearing protection required on the range while the match is being conducted.

Only factory new or safe reloaded ammo is allowed. Only safe firearms are allowed.

The use of an approved Empty Chamber Indicator is required.

A fee of \$3 is charged for each lost challenge.

There will be no lunch break but there will be ample time to eat between relay changes, pit changes, etc.

Competitors must bring their own lunch and drinks. Cold water and portable toilets will be available on the range.

Camping available, with advanced request, beginning at 5 pm on Friday night 7-16-10.

Location: Entrance to The Racine County Line Rifle Club is located on 7 Mile Road ~ ¼ mile east of WI Hwy 32 in Racine County, WI. Exit I-94 at 7 mile road and travel east ~5 miles to WI Hwy 32 and turn right, south, and proceed to 6 Mile Road. Turn east on 6 Mile Road and proceed ~ ¼ mile and turn left on Michna Road. Proceed north on Michna Road for ~ 1 mile and turn left on 7 mile road, proceeding ~ ¼ mile to the access road, east of the RR tracks. Follow the road to the club entrance. Watch for the RCLRC signage and come to the club house for registration and check-in every day. Do not enter the sheriff’s range at the north end of Michna road. Observe the speed limits, be aware of bicyclists, free ranging fowl and livestock on Michna road and watch for power plant construction traffic.

WI FORCE Service Rifle Team Match
7-17-10 pm and 7-18-10 am

The 4-man Team Championship match:

The 600 yard stage follows the Individual Championship Match on 7-17-10 pm.

The 200 and 300 yard stages begin on Sunday morning at 8 am, 7-18-10.

Fee: adult team \$32 junior team \$24

The National Match course of fire:

50 rounds for record with 2 sighting shots at each stage for each team member.

Coaching allowed and encouraged.

NRA rules apply.

Block time will be given.

Stage 1: 200 yards, 2 sighting shots and 10 shots for record slow fire offhand.

Stage 2: 200 yards, 2 sighting shots and 1 string of 10 shots with reload, rapid fire, sitting or kneeling.

Stage 3: 300 yards, 2 sighting shots and 1 string of 10 shots with reload, rapid fire, prone.

Stage 4: 600 yards, 2 sighting shots and 10 shots for record, slow fire prone.

Targets: SR, SR-3 and MR

Awards: cash awards and WI FORCE travelling trophies, as available, awarded to team match winner, junior team winner and winning team in class provided there are at least 5 teams in each class. Where there are not 5 teams in a class, they will be combined with the next higher class. High Master class will not be combined with any other class and will be eligible for team match winner award only.

Travelling trophies and Service Rifle Team Champion status awarded only to WI FORCE members. All other winners will be awarded cash prizes only.

This is a CMP Service Rifle Match

50 shot National Match Course of Fire. 200, 300 and 600 yard firing. No sighting shots and no coaching allowed. Iron sights.

Course of fire:

stage 1: 200 yards slow fire offhand, 10 shots in 10 minutes.

stage 2: 200 yards sitting or kneeling from standing, 1 string of (mandatory reload) 10 shots in 60 seconds.

stage 3: 300 yards prone from standing, 1 string of (mandatory reload) 10 shots in 70 seconds.

stage 4: 600 yards slow fire prone, 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Stages 1 and 2 will be fired in succession. Competitors must stand for the rapid fire stages.

Targets: decimal SR, SR-3 and MR

Entry: Sunday, July 18th 2010. Entries accepted beginning at 7:30 am and entry closes at ~ 12:30 pm

Entry fee: \$15 for all competitors, payable in cash or check to RCLRC.

Entry limited to 48 competitors, with priority given to non-Distinguished competitors.

Eligibility: as established by CMP rules, all competitors must verify on their score card their eligibility to participate. **Reference: www.odcmp.com for all CMP information.**

Competitors must have on CMP file or submit with entry an Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement.

Rules: current CMP rules will be followed.

Equipment: Current U.S. Service Rifles (or civilian equivalent) required.

The M-1 Garand, the M-14 (or M1A), the M-16 (or AR 15). Competitors may share equipment. The use of spotting scopes, shooting stools, slings, ground mats, etc. is allowed. Trigger pull will be weighed. A minimum of a 4.5 pound trigger will be allowed.

Awards: appropriate medals and points towards Distinguished Rifleman as awarded by the Civilian Marksmanship Program.

Competitors will shoot, score and have pit and other duties as assigned. Change over and prep time will be given. Artificial support of any kind is prohibited.

This match may not be fired for practice or fun. All score cards must be returned to CMP.

A fee of \$3 will be charged for all lost challenges. It is not necessary to fire in the NRA events to compete in this match. Competitors must furnish their own food, water, safe ammo and safe service rifle for this event. Portable toilet facilities are available on the range.

There will be door prizes of significant value for this match. All competitors will be eligible. Drawing will be after the match. Must be present to win. Not a raffle.

Location: Racine County Line Rifle Club, Racine, WI

Exit I-94 at 7 Mile road, proceed east ~5 miles on 7 Mile road to WI hwy 32. Turn right, south, on WI hwy 32 and proceed to 6 Mile road. Turn left on 6 Mile road and proceed ~ ¼ mile to Michna road. Turn left on Michna road and go north 1 mile to 7 Mile road. Turn left and proceed west on 7 Mile road ~ ¼ mile to the gravel access road, east of the RR tracks. Turn right and follow the access road north ~ ½ mile to the RCLRC entrance. Watch for the signage, observe the speed limit, be aware of the bicyclists, free ranging fowl and livestock on Michna road and do not enter the Sheriff's range on the north end of Michna road. Watch for power plant construction activities and equipment.
