4-GUN 600 YD MID-RANGE MATCH

DATE: Sunday, August 22, 2010 (entries close 7:30 am) (starts at 8:00 am)

LOCATION: The Winnequah Gun Club range, approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). **New Entrance Address is W10219 Larson Dr, Lodi WI 53555.** Continue on J and V approximately one mile. Continue on Cty Hwy V approximately ¼ mile to the new Indoor Range on the left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the new road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. Signs will be posted. Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles.

ELIGIBILITY: NRA membership is no longer required for people to compete in NRA tournaments. F Class competitors are encouraged to attend the match.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle and NRA Mid-Range Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors. Bring a Temporary Score Book or results bulletin for proof of scores.

SAFETY: *Bolts cannot be closed until the rifle is shouldered and pointed towards the target.*

EQUIPMENT:

- NRA Match Rifle – Rule 3.3, Iron Sight
- NRA Match Rifle – Any Sight, Rule 3.3.4
- Palma® Rifle – Rule 3.3.3, Iron Sight
- Palma® Rifle – Any Sight
- Any Rifle Iron Sight – Rule 3.7(a)(2)
- Any Rifle Any Sight – Rule 3.7(c)
- Service Rifle – Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 (inc. .223 Rem)
- "F" Class – See Rule 3.4.1 in NRA Fullbore Rifle Rules.
- AROS – Any Rifle, Optics, Sling: separate category from "F" class; **NO** sandbags, other rests or muzzle brakes allowed. If shooting in the AROS category, you must stay in this category for all matches.

ENTRIES: Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA Mid- Range classification. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6- Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry. **IF YOU ARE NOT CHECKED IN AT THE STAT OFFICE 30 MINUTES BEFORE FIRING TIME, YOUR SPOT WILL BE GIVEN TO A PERSON ON THE WAITING LIST.** Mail individual entry form with correct fees to:

Individual match entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (112) until August 18. Entries received after August 18 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee. Confirmations will be sent by email if possible.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding cards for individual matches will be issued from the Statistical Office. **Competitors must report to the Stat Office before firing that day.** NRA Mid- Range classification card must be shown before squadding is issued. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose his/her right to compete in that event.

COURSE OF FIRE: (all matches are 2 sighters and 20 shots for record)(competitors will score and pull targets). The NRA International Fullbore Prone scoring system will be used in slow fire matches (Rule 14.18(b)). Sample cards will be given at registration.

Stage 1: NRA Match Rifle/Palma® Rifle, Iron Sights

Stage 2: NRA Match Rifle/Palma® Rifle, Any Sights

Stage 3: Any Rifle, Any Sight

Stage 4: Any Rifle, Iron Sight

Match 5: Grand Aggregate (Stages 1,2,3,4)

AWARDS: Awards will be given to the individual Match Winners in each match. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be given only if there are 5, 10, 15 or more competitors in a given match and class. If there are fewer than 5 High Masters entered, they must fire for open awards only. High Master Class may not be combined with the Master Class. If there are fewer than the required number of entries in a class to provide awards, they will be combined with the same class in another category.

“F” CLASS COMPETITORS: All individual events are open to participation by F-Class competitors. Awards in the F-Class will be made based upon the number of F-Class competitors in each match in F-Open and F-TR categories.

AROS - Any Rifle, Optics, Sling: An award will be given for the highest AROS competitor provided five (5) or more are entered. AROS competitors are not eligible for Overall or Class awards in the matches.
